

What Percent Of My Income Does My Current Offering Represent?

(Before or After Taxes)

To determine the answer: On the top row, look for the amount that approximates your annual income (either before or after taxes). Then, in the first column, look for the amount that approximates your weekly offering.

Interpreting the percent correctly: “one percent” is shown as “1.00%”. Less than one percent is any number beginning with a zero followed by a decimal point, such as “0.070%” which is the same as the fraction “7/100th” of one percent.
